("AETRS"), by and through its Board of Directors, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (Bureau) issued a Consent Order on October 1, 2012, for violations of Sections 1031 and 1036 of the Consumer Financial Protection Act of 2010, 12 U.S.C. §§ 5531 and 5536,

To this date, AETRS has fulfilled its obligations under the Consent Order, including, among other things, providing appropriate redress to affected consumers, and paying a civil money penalty of \$9 million.

Accordingly, under Paragraph 14 of the Consent Order, the Bureau directs that the Consent Order be, and it hereby is, terminated this 31 day of August, 2017.
